

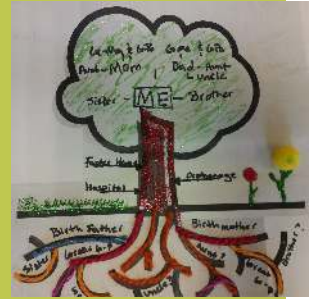

Adoptee Youth Group 6 Week Series

This **9 hour group** (1.5hrs weekly for 6 weeks) offers space to share with other adoptees about our adoption experience.

- Topics (not limited to): **adoptee friendships, adoption and school, adoption in the media...**
- Through crafts, games and activities youth are encouraged to **normalize and celebrate** their experience as adoptees. This group is designed and facilitated by adoption professionals who are also adoptees themselves.
- Designed to take full advantage of the benefits inherent to **mentorship relationships**. Older youth, or youth who have taken a past series, are given the option of participating as “mentors” to the younger participants. Must be 14 years old or older.
- **Prerequisite for all Youth Activity Groups** ~ at least one parent is required to attend the Virtual Adoptive Parent Group (please contact Astrid for more information).
